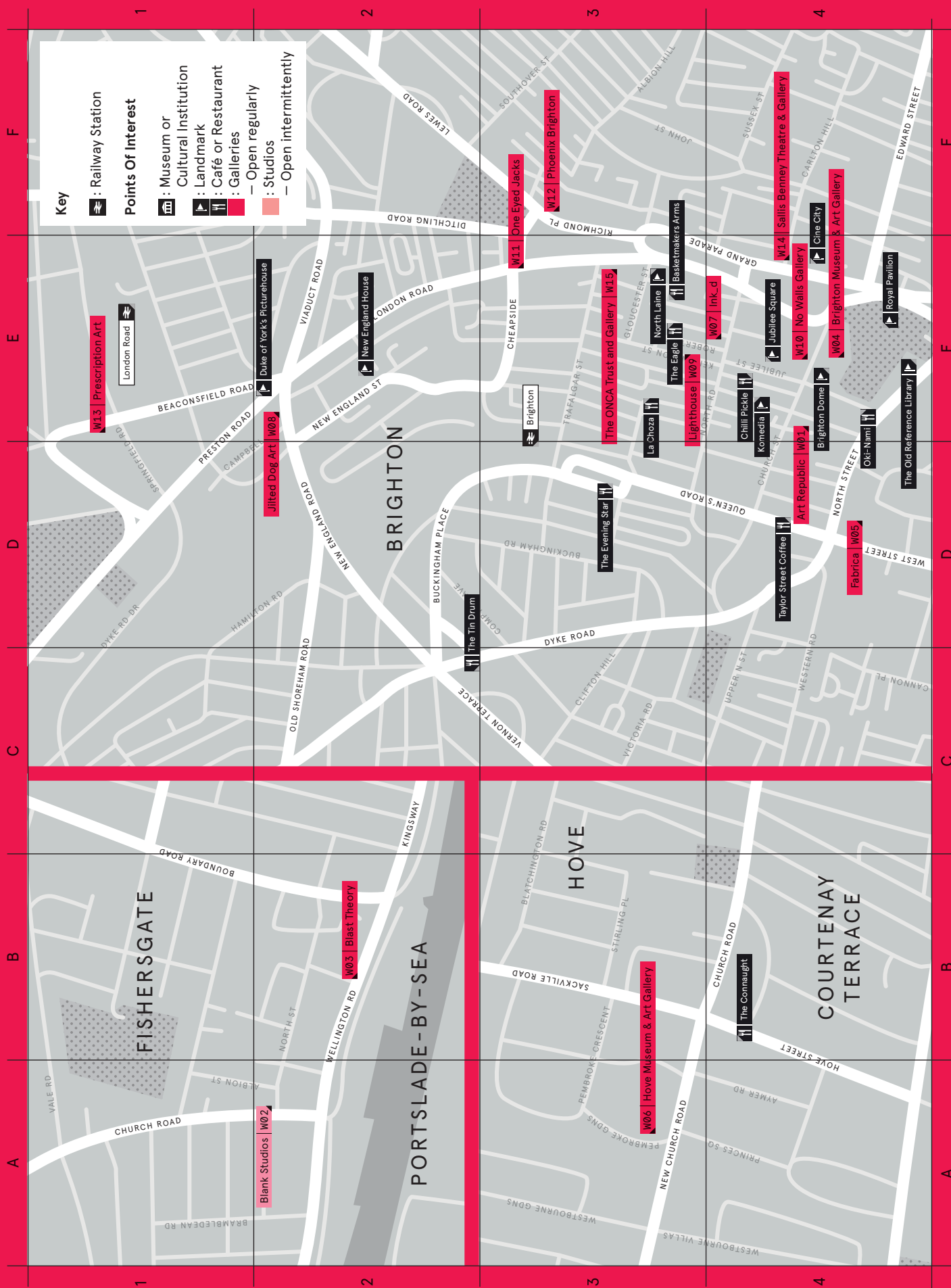
The seaside city of Brighton & Hove is renowned as a creative hub and home to hundreds of artists and makers, surprisingly, though, it doesn't have a major, dedicated contemporary art gallery. What could be seen as a negative has become a positive force for artists and creatives to respond to the challenge with a range of artist and curator-led nationally recognised, independent galleries, such as **Fabrica**, **Lighthouse**, **Phoenix Brighton** and **ONCA**, mostly situated around Brighton's central Artists Quarter. **The University of Brighton** and **Brighton Museum & Art Gallery** also show frequent

exhibitions. Other commercial galleries include **Ink.d**, **No Walls**, **IO**, **Cameron Contemporary** and **Art Republic**.

Of vital importance to Brighton is its series of arts festivals running through-out the year, starting with the **Brighton Festival**, **Brighton Fringe**, **HOUSE** and **AOH** festivals in May and leading on to the **Digital Festival**, **CineCity** and **Photo Biennial** through the summer into autumn, winding up with the **AOH Christmas festival**. Also don't miss out on the **Brighton Art Fair** in September and **Made** in November, both at the Corn Exchange, next to **Brighton Dome**.
