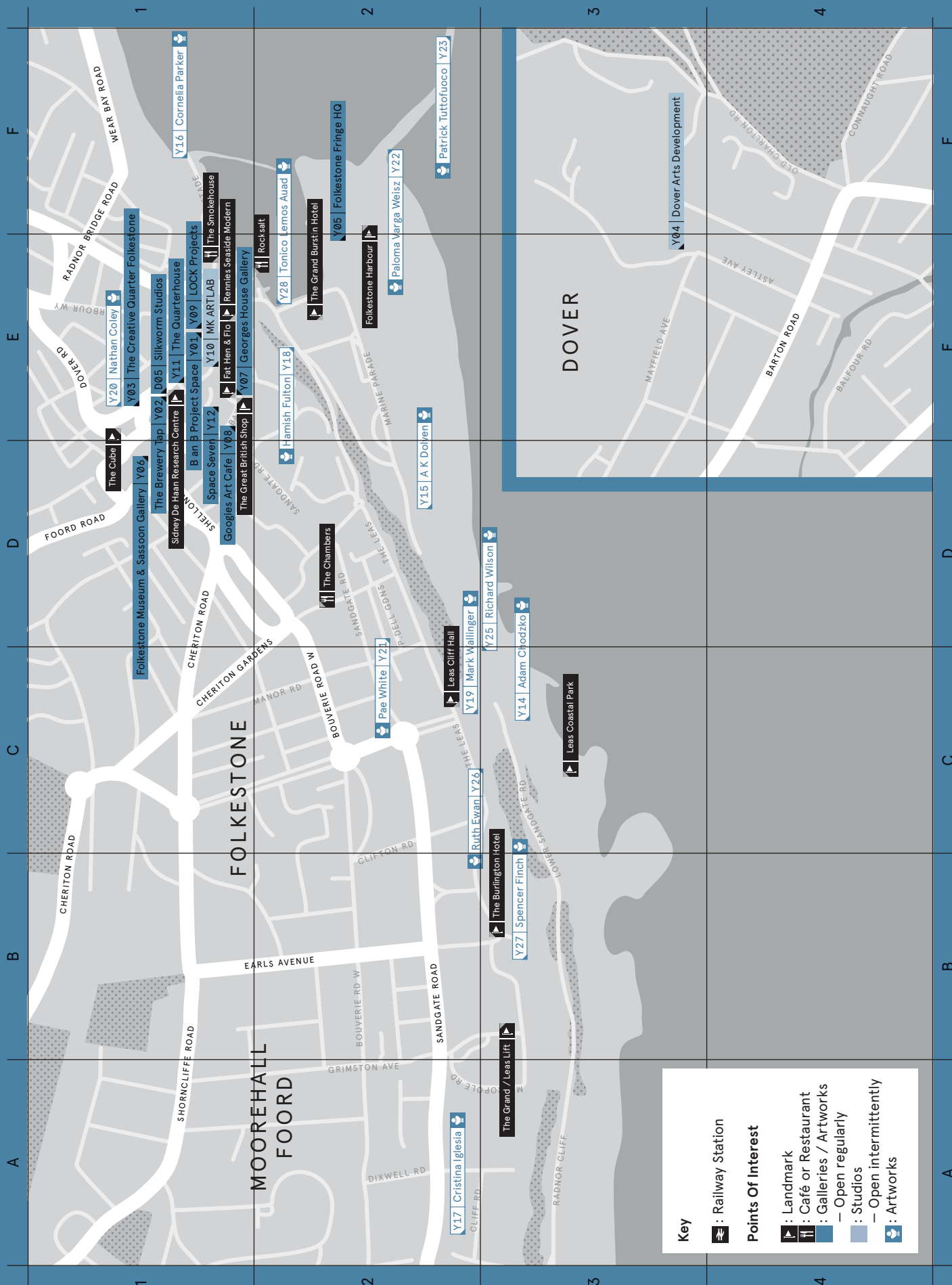
Artist, curator, gallerist and true Folkestone ambassador **Matt Rowe** gives us the low down on Folkestone's vibrant cultural quarter and the unmissable Folkestone Triennial returning to town in 2014.

Folkestone's art scene has been rapidly and organically developing alongside a cultural regeneration project that is centred around the former ferry port. For day trippers a short train ride on HS1 will lead them to an abundance of contemporary sculptural installations and more between. These **Folkestone Artworks** will help visitors navigate the town, offering artistic interpretation of the town's unique heritage. The majority of these works have been commissioned by the **Folkestone Triennial**, a flagship project

managed by the Creative Foundation, who also provide studio space in the creative quarter situated near to the harbour area.

Artist led venues such as the **B&B Project Space**, **George's House Galley** and the **Brewery Tap** host projects and exhibitions by emerging contemporary artists. For more work outside of gallery walls don't miss the **Folkestone Fringe**: A program of events for artists to develop new works and interventions.

Folkestone also offers an ideal staging post to explore the surrounding district of Shepway. A short miniature train ride from the nearby town of Hythe will transport you to the UK's only desert and former home of Derrick Jarman in Dungeness. The area is now home to a bustling community of artists and independent galleries Folkestone is a gateway town, a point of arrival and departure, a vibrant cultural destination and a place definitely worth discovering.
